1. President Chris Horant called the meeting to order at 7:05PM.

1. Maryland House Bill 550 proposes changing the age requirements and placing driving restrictions for cars tagged as Historic vehicles. Chris has been informed by SEMA (an industry lobbyist group) that the bill has attracted so much attention and so many amendments that it is forecasted to be reclassified as “Further Study”, and is expected to die in committee without a vote by the General Assembly this session.
2. Jerry Wojtowycz has volunteered to take some excess parts offered by Mark Raspi and store them on behalf of the Club. An inventory will be posted, and members will be able to access the parts free of charge. In the event of multiple requests for the same items, a lottery or other random selection method will be put in place.
3. No one has stepped forward and volunteered as Chairperson to lead Brits By the Bay. Because of the late date, the Board of Directors will make a decision on how to proceed.

New Business

1. The Economy Run will be chaired by Paul and Kathy Hagert. The Poker Run will be chaired by Jerry Wojtowycz and Eric Mephram.
2. A monthly Scenic Drive has been added to TRAC’s 2012 calendar. Members are urged to lead one or more of these drives this summer.
